

Care and Maintenance



Care of Wood Finishes

The fine finish applied during manufacture is a hard protective lacquer resistant to moderate heat and spillages of some beverages, but not alcohol. All spillages should be wiped off immediately with a slightly damp cloth. The only cleaning necessary is again to wipe with a slightly damp cloth and buff with a soft duster. Under no circumstances should a silicone polish or wax be used as these damage the finish and prevent the furniture from being refinished.

Care of Fabric Upholstery

Regular vacuum cleaning is recommended. Marks and stains should be removed with a proprietary cleaner.

Care of Leather Upholstery

Wipe with a slightly damp cloth and gently rub dry. A good proprietary hide food should be applied at least once a year, and more often if the leather is in a dry atmosphere or close to a heat source. Do not use saddle soap, wax polishes or spray polishes.

Care Of Nylon Parts

Wipe with a damp cloth periodically.

Care of Aluminium and Steel

These will be chrome plated or powder coated and you should clean this with a damp cloth and buff up with a dry cloth. For Chromium plated finishes, stains [coffee etc] can be removed using a metal cleaner such as Brasso, we would not recommend the use of an abrasive cleaning agent.

Care of Laminates

In most cases, you only need to use a clean, damp, non-abrasive cotton cloth, and a mild liquid detergent or household cleaner. Rinse with clean water, using a clean, non-abrasive cotton cloth. Do not flood the laminate, especially near seams, since water can penetrate and cause the substrate to swell. Dry the surface with a soft, clean, non-abrasive cotton cloth.

Care of Glass

Wipe with a damp cloth periodically and buff with a dry, non-abrasive cloth.

NOTE: DO NOT PLUG VACUUM DIRECTLY INTO OUTLETS WITHIN THE ORANGETBOX.
